The program includes nationally known speakers and a day at the state Capitol.

Contest Guidelines

STUDENT ELIGIBILITY:

This contest is open to any high school or home-schooled sophomore who attends a school in the Boone Electric Cooperative service area. *Children of BEC Directors are not eligible to enter.*

APPLICATION CONTENT:

The following items must be submitted to be considered for the 2024 CYCLE Leadership Program. Please use this as a checklist.

- A signed and dated copy of the completed 2024 CYCLE application.
- A reference letter from an adult in your community (teacher, counselor, minister, etc.).
- A brief paragraph stating why you would like to be chosen as a CYCLE delegate.

Write a 300-500 word essay on the theme, "What moment or event in American or Missouri history do you wish you could have witnessed? How is that moment significant to the U.S. or to Missouri? Why is it meaningful to you? If you had been part of it, what would have been able to contribute?" *Be sure to write about a specific moment or event, not a broad time period. Essays should be typed or legibly handwritten. Do not include your name on your paragraph or essay pages. Applications will be judged for creativity, accuracy, clarity, grammar, punctuation and the level of independent research.

APPLICATION DELIVERY AND DEADLINE:

Applications must be postmarked or received in Boone Electric's office no later than Friday, March 1, 2024 at 5 p.m.

FINALISTS:

Finalists will be notified no later than <u>March 22, 2024</u> via email or letter. Judges will review the applications and essays to determine six delegates for the CYCLE leadership conference. Delegates will be invited to attend a reception on <u>April 9, 2024</u>. Decisions of the judges will be final.
