Power Cost Adjustment

The Power Cost Adjustment, or PCA, is a variable energy rate which can fluctuate from month to month based on wholesale power costs. In other words, when the cost of power purchased by Boone Electric exceeds the amount presently included in our base rates, the PCA adjusts the price of electricity to make up the difference on an as-needed basis. This helps keep base electric rates stable and appears as the PCA line item.

Electric Service

The actual cost of electricity used (measured in kilowatt-hours, or kWh) by the member at their home or business based on rates that became effective April 1, 2023.

Service Availability

The service availability charge is a flat fee per meter which covers the fixed costs of operating the distribution system's infrastructure such as poles, lines, transformers and other equipment.

Round Up

Round Up is a line item only on bills for those members who participate in Operation Round Up. Members may choose to round up their monthly electric bill to the next highest dollar amount, with the difference in change going to the Boone Electric Community Trust. Participants donate an average of \$6 per year which are cumulatively awarded to nonprofit and public entities by the Boone Electric Community Trust.
